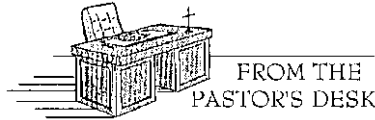

Dear Friends,

After last week's storm my mind turns to the seventh chapter of the Gospel of Matthew: "Anyone who hears my words and puts them into practice is like the wise man who built his house on rock. When the rainy season set in, the torrents came and the winds blew and buffeted his house. It did not collapse; it had been solidly set on rock."

Since being your pastor, our church has been buffeted not only by wind and rain but by heavy snow and even an earthquake. And still it stands. Events such as these remind me that as important as it is to have our buildings look nice, structural integrity is key. The safety and longevity of any building requires regularly going beneath the surface and assessing the parts we normally do not see and often take for granted. Sometimes a visible and obvious problem indicates a more significant problem beneath the surface. It is also true that sometimes a serious underlying problem is not manifested in an obvious way until after catastrophic failure.

All of this, of course, is a metaphor for our lives. In the sacrament of penance we look deeply into our lives and examine our consciences in light of the Gospel. What is the state of our moral integrity? What are the minor vices (both actions and attitudes) that have slowly seeped into our hearts making easier access for even more serious vices? Is my life simply a façade of niceness and polite social conventions or am I truly welded onto the Body of Christ and animated in the depth of my being by the manifold gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit?

As we continue to assess our facilities at St. Leo and carry out needed repairs this summer, may we each do the same for ourselves. As important as church buildings are in assisting us in carrying out our Christian mission, nothing is as important as the church which is the people redeemed by Christ and drawn together by faith. What repairs must we make in our relationships to God and neighbor? What will be our routine of regular spiritual maintenance?

Change in Grace Period for Virtus Seminar To prepare adult volunteers to work with children, the Diocese of Arlington continues to use *Virtus: Protecting God's Children* as its safe-environment program. This, combined with the completion, review & clearance of all diocesan background check forms by the Office for the Protection of Children and Young People, constitutes an individual in full compliance with the diocesan child protection & safety program. ***It is required that the Virtus safe-environment training be completed in a timely fashion. On July 1, 2012, the grace period for completing the Virtus component changed from 180 days to 45 days.*** To facilitate this adjustment, the OPCYP has trained additional facilitators both in English and in Spanish and is offering sessions more frequently. ***Effective July 1st, it is presumed that volunteers who have not completed Virtus seminar training are no longer working with children and they have been stricken from our files.***

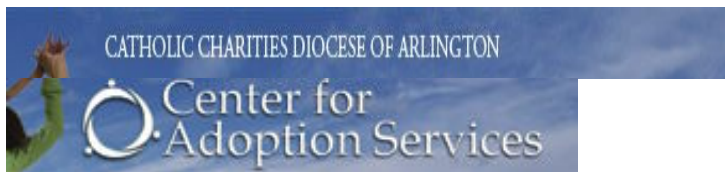

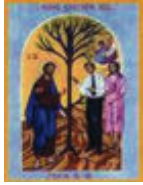
