Dear Friends,

October has been declared Respect Life Month by the bishops of the United States. As Catholic Christians and as citizens of this great nation we are called to a renewed dedication to the belief that all human life is sacred. Not only is the welfare of our community protected and advanced by the increased awareness of the intrinsic value of each human person, the eternal salvation of our souls depends upon it. We are all familiar with parable of the rich man and the beggar Lazarus. The rich man passed by the poor man Lazarus day after day yet remained unmoved in sentiment and action. For such callousness, or maybe even just inattentiveness, he was judged unfit for eternal happiness.

In the face of so many discouraging events and attitudes in our world and closer to home it is easy to give up. The Prophet Habakkuk writes: "How long, O LORD? I cry for help but you do not listen! I cry out to you, 'Violence!' but you do not intervene. Why do you let me see ruin; why must I look at misery? Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and clamorous discord." The Lord does indeed listen and in fact He speaks. He is telling us that we are the instruments He uses to bring about His Kingdom. We are, as members of the Body of Christ, the instruments He employs to establish a more peaceful and just society. He calls us to be not only "believers" but "doers" - Not only to believe in an intellectual or abstract way the notion of the dignity of the human person but to let that belief guide and form our every action from the way we interact on a daily basis with family, friends, and coworkers, to how we consider the social issues facing our community, and to how we make our prudential judgments regarding for whom we vote.

Pope John Paul II was aware of the magnitude of our responsibility: "We are facing an enormous and dramatic clash between good and evil, death and life, the 'culture of death' and the 'culture of life.' We find ourselves not only 'faced with' but necessarily 'in the midst of' this conflict: we are all involved and we all share in it, with the inescapable responsibility of choosing to be unconditionally pro-life. (#28)... It is impossible to further the common good without acknowledging and defending the right to life, upon which all the other inalienable rights of individuals are founded and from which they develop." (#101) *Pope John Paul II - The Gospel of Life*

Our bishops too have unequivocally stated that "The failure to protect and defend life in its most vulnerable stages renders suspect any claims to the 'rightness' of positions in other matters affecting the poorest and least powerful of the human community. If we understand the human person as the 'temple of the Holy Spirit' -- the living

house of God -- then these latter issues fall logically into place as the crossbeams and walls of that house. ... All direct attacks on innocent human life, such as abortion and euthanasia, strike at the house's foundation. These directly and immediately violate the human person's most fundamental right -- the right to life. Neglect of these issues is the equivalent of building our house on sand." *Living the Gospel of Life - A Challenge to American Catholics #23*

We examine our own hearts and actions this month mindful of the Lord's merciful understanding of our weakness. We ask for the strength and humility needed to speak the truth and to live consistently in our lives the fullness of what is revealed to us concerning the dignity of every person. I recommend to all the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' website -- www.usccb.org. Here you will find links to helpful resources to learn more and to discern more fully the voice of Christ as it pertains to the many "life issues" of our time.

LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR COLLECTION October 27/28

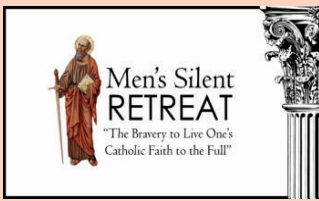
