Dear Friends,

I will always remember the time when I was in college and called my mom on January 18 profusely apologizing that I had failed to wish her a happy birthday the day before. My words were met with silence. The silence was followed by a simple question and then a statement: "How many mothers do you have? My birthday is in February." The answer to my mom's question is "two".

As Catholic Christians we acknowledge only Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. He is the Eternal Son of the Father who humbly takes flesh in the womb of Mary by the power of the Holy Spirit. He becomes man. He offers the real and perfect sacrifice of love on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins and the beginning of our participation in His Divine Life. His sacrifice is real – He is true man. His sacrifice is perfect – He is true God.

But the scriptures are also clear that we are His adopted brothers and sisters. As members of His Body we share His life and His mission. He is the One Priest yet we share in that priesthood by offering our lives in loving service to all because of His love. He is the Prophet knowing the Will of the Father yet we share in His work of sharing God's word. He is the King and Shepherd of the Universe yet we also are called to lead others to the Father.

October is traditionally a month during which we celebrate God's great gift to us of Mary. Mary, the woman of faith, is both a model of perfect trust in God and our mother always praying to her Divine Son on our behalf. As citizens and residents of the United States we have particular devotion to her under her title of the "Immaculate Conception". She, who was conceived without sin by a singular grace of Allmighty God in view of the redemptive sacrifice of Jesus Christ, draws us more deeply into the mystery of Divine Love.

Mary is a creature, like you and me. In honoring her we give glory to God and the power of His Grace to transform the human person. Mary acknowledges that she is but a lowly "handmaid". In the scripture she correctly states that "All nations shall call me blessed because Holy is His name." Mary, filled with the Holy Spirit, says "Yes" to God always. She nurtures, cares for, and loves her Divine Son. She presents to Him the needs of others as we see in the Gospel of John at the wedding feast at Cana. She stands with Him in solidarity with His redemptive sacrifice at the foot of the cross. At the foot of the cross the final words of Jesus include His giving her to the Apostle John as his mother and His giving him to her as her son. As followers of Jesus this was a gift given to us as well.

Just as Jesus turned to Mary, as a child will always do, we

also turn to her confident that just as she loved Jesus she also loves us. She supports us by her prayers as we move closer to our one Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.


