Dear Friends,

This Monday October 22 we celebrate the Memorial of Pope St. John Paul II. It was Pope St. John Paul who beatified Mother Teresa on October 19, 2003. For me, these two saints go “hand in hand”. They formed a strong spiritual bond with each other sharing intensely and mystically in both the joy and the suffering of Christ. I think of her especially in light of our Scripture reading this Sunday.

In 2007 (ten years after her death) a collection of her private letters was published: *Mother Teresa: Come Be My Light: The Private Writings of the “Saint of Calcutta.”* Many of the words she uses in opening her heart to her spiritual directors and ecclesiastical authorities go against the image many of us have long associated with Saint Mother Teresa—a pious, selfless individual who was as steadfast in her faith as she was to her service to the poor. She appeared always as one who never wavered from her faith. She was firm and resolute. The reality is that for half of her life – the entire time she served the poorest of the poor she did give voice to interior doubt and the complete absence of any consoling “feeling” of God’s presence.

Some are scandalized to learn this about Blessed Mother Teresa. But, in reality, knowing that she struggled with her faith—even doubting whether God even existed—gives us great hope and encouragement. It shows us that Blessed Mother Teresa endured hardships, struggles, and most importantly doubted her faith just like many of us can do at times.

Blessed Mother Teresa always greeted the world with her iconic white and blue-striped sari and her endearing smile. Inside, however, she was secretly tormented and suffering over her lost faith. She even referred to her smile as “a mask” or “a cloak that covers everything.” Blessed Mother Teresa’s personal letters were never meant to be viewed by the public. In fact, it was her wish that all her letters be destroyed. The Vatican insisted that some of her letters be preserved as relics should she one day become a saint. Very few people knew how anguished she was about her faith, but for nearly 50 years, Blessed Mother Teresa used pen and paper to express how she felt “no presence of God whatsoever.”

One letter in particular touches my heart. She writes this to her spiritual director on July 3, 1959:

“Lord, my God, who am I that You should forsake me? The child of your love – and now become as the most hated one—the one You have thrown away as unwanted – unloved, I call, I cling, I want – and there is no One to answer – no


One on Whom I can cling- no One. Alone. The darkness is so dark – I am alone. Unwanted, forsaken. – The loneliness of the heart that wants love is unbearable. – Where is my faith? Even deep down, right in, there is nothing but emptiness and darkness. My God – how painful is this unknown pain. It pains without ceasing. I have no faith. I dare not utter the words and thoughts that crowd my heart and make me suffer untold agony. So many unanswered questions live within me - I am afraid to uncover them – because of the blasphemy – If there be God, - please forgive me.-Trust all will end in Heaven with Jesus. When I try to raise my thoughts to heaven- there is such convicting emptiness that those very thoughts return like sharp knives and hurt my very soul.- Love- the word- it brings nothing. I am told God loves me – and yet the reality of darkness and coldness and emptiness is so great that nothing touches my soul....In spite of all- this darkness and emptiness is not as painful as the longing for God....If this brings You glory, if you get a drop of joy from this – if souls are brought to You – if my suffering satiates Your Thirst- here I am Lord, with joy I accept all to the end of life- and I will smile at Your hidden Face – always.”

Why did Blessed Mother Teresa suffer so much darkness and even moments of apparent despair in her life? Why didn’t God release such a dedicated, selfless woman from her misery? It took almost her entire life, yet Saint Mother Teresa (with the help of one of her spiritual advisers) came to the realization that her suffering was meant to bring her closer to the suffering Jesus endured on the cross and the suffering of the poor she served. She finally realized her feelings of being abandoned by God only heightened her sensitivity to the feelings of abandonment and despair the poor and sick people around her were experiencing.

After reading her letters, I will never again see St. Teresa a woman who did really good things and became famous. No. She is one of the greatest saints of all time. She is the model of what true faith is. St. Teresa and Pope St. John Paul pray for us.
