Dear Friends,

During the month of November Catholics traditionally remember the dead in prayer. We give thanks for the goodness and blessings of all the saints who show us what the power of God's grace can achieve in the human person –those officially canonized and the many more known only to God. Through prayer, we unite ourselves more closely to friends, family, and all the dead whose faith is known to God alone. We pray for all who have gone before us, and in so doing, are made more mindful of our own destiny. Each one of us will someday be called from this life to stand before Christ our judge. Christ our Judge is Love. He identifies with our weakness and is so eager to give to us the grace, mercy, favor, and the help we seek. He emptied Himself of glory to share perfectly our brokenness. He freely poured out His blood for the forgiveness of our sins. He reaches out to us to give us His life in abundance. He is close to us and supports us in our times of loss.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that "all who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. The Church gives the name *Purgatory* to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. This teaching is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: 'Therefore Judas Maccabeus made atonement for the dead that they might be delivered from their sin.' From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers of suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead: 'Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice. Why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them.'"

At the heart of the Church's teaching concerning Purgatory is the belief in a God who is both perfectly just and merciful. He desires nothing other than our complete transformation by grace into that perfect man or woman we were created to become. The doctrine of Purgatory is also a reminder of the truth that the bonds of love which tie us together in this life do not unravel at the moment of death. If only we could see with the eyes of faith, we would know that we are never more close and more present to those we

love than when we pray for them and with them.

This Thursday is November 1 – The Solemnity of All Saints which is a Holy Day of Obligation. Please see the Mass times in the bulletin. Friday November 2 is the Memorial of All Souls. In addition to the regular weekday Masses at 6:15 AM and 9 AM, we will celebrate a special Mass for all who have died this past year at 7:30 PM. **Because of this special Mass there will be no Holy Hour and Confessions this Friday evening November 2.**

On November 7 we begin our annual celebration of 40 Hours. The Eucharist will be exposed on the altar all day and night until the evening of November 9. The Second Vatican Council reminds all of us that the Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian life. The Eucharist which is Jesus Christ made present to us is the "source" for it is truly from the Lord that we have been given the gift of life and every other gift which flows from it. It is the Lord who continues to give to us every blessing and even the faith, strength, and courage to experience His peace in times that might seem to be anything but "blessed". The Eucharist is the "summit" since our communion with Him in this sacrament is the foretaste of our perfect unity with Him in heaven. I encourage all to spend time with the Lord during those days – individuals, families, and members of all our parish groups. Again, please see the bulletin for additional information.

While classes are part of the process, RCIA is more than a class; it is a gradual introduction to the customs, beliefs, practices, and devotions of Catholicism.
