Dear Friends,

One of the scribes came to Jesus and asked him,  
"Which is the first of all the commandments?"

Jesus replied, "The first is this: *Hear, O Israel!*

*The Lord our God is Lord alone!*

*You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart,  
with all your soul, with all your mind,  
and with all your strength.*

The second is this: *You shall love your neighbor  
as yourself.*

There is no other commandment greater than these."

These words begin our Gospel Reading this Sunday. Words which are very clear and simple. Words which are many times more difficult to live. All sin in some way is a variation on the theme of Pride - the deadliest of the deadly sins. Pride is not necessarily believing that we are better than others (in some ways and at some times we might be as regards natural ability and talent and achievement). Rather, pride is essentially a stance of life that sees all, thinks all, experiences all from the perspective of self. What Jesus says today is a challenge and invitation to reach out of self. Recognize the ultimate source of life which is God. We are creatures who do not bring ourselves into being nor sustain our own existence. We reach out of self when we see in the other also a creature loved as well by God. The ancient Jewish prayer "Hear, O Israel!" is a call to return to right relationship with God from which flows right relationship with neighbor. It is the key to fullness of life not only for the People of God thousands of years ago but for each one of us right now. In the midst of the "crisis" the Church experiences because of acts of abuse, cover-ups, and lack of accountability these words are even more urgent.

November 12 through November 15 the bishops of the United States will gather in Baltimore. They will pray, confess their guilt, do penance, and seek the wisdom and courage which are gifts of the Holy Spirit as they develop concrete proposals which seek to heal those broken by the sins of the clergy and to begin the long process of restoring our trust in their leadership. At St. Leo we will have a Holy Hour Monday November 12 beginning at 7:30 PM. This will be a time to pray not only for the victims of abuse but for the bishops as well. We need them to be good shepherds and humble spiritual fathers.

On Tuesday November 20 our Deacon Marques Silva (also Director of the Arlington Office of Child Protection) and I will lead a discussion on what is happening nationally concerning the abuse of minors and others and also very importantly what the history and current situation in our own diocese is. We will provide

information on the steps that have been taken not only in the diocese but even more specifically here at St. Leo. More details will be in next week's bulletin. ### ADULT FAITH FORMATION

**The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA):** is a process for bringing into the Catholic Church both those who have never been baptized & those who were baptized in a non-Catholic church. RCIA is also the way for adult Catholics who have never been confirmed to prepare for the final Sacrament of Initiation, Confirmation. We invite any adult who would like to join the Catholic Church, be confirmed, or who is simply interested in learning about the teachings and customs of Catholic Christianity to come and join us. While classes are part of the process, RCIA is more than a class; it is a gradual introduction to the customs, beliefs, practices, and devotions of Catholicism. There is no obligation, only an opportunity to learn! **RCIA 2018-2019 classes are Tuesdays from 7:30-9:00 PM in the Guadalupe Room.** There is no need to register in advance. Registration will take place in class.
